Bins and boxes should be put out by 7.00 a.m.

On Bank Holidays and Saturdays the bin or box should be out by 6.00 a.m.

or on your calendar denotes a Bank Holiday or Saturday collection.

Please check your Christmas collection dates carefully, normal service will resume on 3rd January 2012. One bag of rubbish beside the wheeled bin is allowed on the first refuse collection after Christmas.

Please help reduce rubbish going to landfill by recycling. On one week the wheeled bin contents are collected (see on calendar) and the following week the recyclable material in the green box is collected (see on calendar).

HOW TO USE YOUR 2 CONTAINERS



The following can go into your recycling box:

- **Glass bottles and jars** (to save water please wash out when you do your washing up)
- **Paper**, newspapers, magazines, telephone directories, junk mail and pamphlets (a small amount of shredded paper can be placed in a large envelope - or it could be composted)
- **Envelopes** (not the jiffy type)
- **Yellow Pages**
- **Light card** (cereal packets, greeting cards etc)
- **Steel food and drink cans** (please wash & squash)
- **Aluminium (not foil) food and drink cans** (please wash & squash)
- **Aerosols**
- **Textiles**, handbags, belts, soft toys (please keep dry in a bag)
- **Shoes** (tied together)

Anything that you cannot recycle or compost can go into your wheeled bin.

You can put out as much recycling as you like in additional small bags with handles or boxes (that are no larger than the recycling box).

Plastic bottles can be recycled at your nearest recycling centre (contact the helpline to find a site near you)



Anything that you cannot recycle or compost can go into your wheeled bin. N.B. no garden waste and bin lid must be firmly closed.

Garden waste can be composted. Please call the helpline for information on the latest composter offers!
